As part of efforts to listen to the citizens of Ghana {Ukraine} and involve everyone in the process of personality development, we have launched a new forum that primarily seeks to gather all the brilliant ideas suggestions, contributions and criticisms we need as people to help build a better community.

2.2. MEMBERSHIP CARD.

As the Association grows, there is the need to properly recognize her members. Each member will be given a membership card for a proper identification. The card will be used as clearance to various functions organized by the GSA-D or affiliates were needed and will be one of the documents needed to enjoy certain incentives. It will aid in quick identification of members during emergencies.

3.1. STUDENT HOSPITAL AFFILIATION

5.1 EQUIPPING THE ENTERTAINMENT DEPARTMENT

7.1. GSAD CONSOLIDATION FUND

The number will remain as the perpetual telephone number of the GSAD. This will end the practice where the Association has to change telephone numbers in every new administration.
